Sapolsky keeps going--next to the question of what features of the environment affected that person's brain, and then back to the childhood of the individual, and then to their genetic makeup. Finally, he expands the view to encompass factors larger than that one individual: what culture has shaped that individual's group, what ecological factors helped shape that culture, and on and on, all the way to evolutionary factors thousands and even millions of years old. The result is one of the most dazzling achievements in the horizon of the science of human behavior ever attempted, a majestic synthesis that harvests cutting-edge research across a range of disciplines to provide a subtle and nuanced perspective on why we ultimately do the things we do...for good and for ill. Sapolsky builds on this understanding to wrestle with some of our deepest and most nagging questions relating to tribalism and xenophobia, hierarchy and competition, morality and free will, and violence and peace.
